# Pastor's Corner

#### **Good Things are Happening**

As Spring blooms and we rapidly move towards the growing season of Summer, Kirkland UMC is blooming and growing as well.

#### Blooming in Worship:

In January 2025, we averaged 32 people weekly in Worship (In-house & Online). By the end of March our weekly attendance is 43. Sunday School attendance in January was 0; by the end of March, Sunday school averaged 7. We continue to grow by re-inviting members who have fallen away and new visitors. Let's keep up the good work!

We continue to bloom in our Missional giving and actions. In the first three months of 2025, we received over \$1200 in support for our monthly missions, and the congregation continues to grow in its support for the Kirkland food pantry through gifts of hygiene products for the 400-500 people who use the pantry services each month.

We are blooming in our relationship with the Lutheran Church. To bring Christ to the Kirkland community, we have planned a joint worship in July and November, and a Vacation Bible School in July.

Our Advisory Council is working on a new Mission Statement to better reflect "who" Kirkland UMC is and "why" we are in ministry to the world. All ideas are welcomed and valued. Please add your thoughts to the white sheets at the back of the sanctuary. The Ad Council is also in the process of simplifying the church's administration. The board is working to create a better board to serve our congregation.

Our garden is blooming with some well-planned changes. Our garden volunteer, Marian Collins (who is looking for others to join her), is already hard at work cleaning up the winter fall-off and planning for Spring growth. Dead and dying trees and bushes have been removed, and grass seed will be spread to create a lush garden environment.

Spring also brings with it Lent, Holy Week, and Easter. Palm Sunday is **April 13**, and we plan a children's parade at 10 AM. On **April 17**, at 6:30 PM, we celebrate Maundy (Holy) Thursday with interactive Worship. On **April 18**, Good Friday, at? PM, we have a moving service surrounding the Choir Cantata. **Easter Sunday**, April 20, begins at 9:00 AM with an Easter Continental Breakfast, with Worship following at 10 AM.

As we grow into the summer months, we anticipate reaching out to the Kirkland community and beyond through our missions and ministries during the 4th of July weekend. We need volunteers for the float, the Refresh Station, which will provide hospitality and cool water to all, and the Children's Station, a free and fun place for children and families to cool off and enjoy free water activities.

I praise God, the Great Gardener, who is tending our congregation and allowing us to bloom and grow. Remember that we are a reflection of God's work in the world. Let everyone you meet see the face of Christ and witness its growth in your life.



The pantry thanks you for all your shampoo and deodorant donations over the past two months. Your contributions truly make a difference in the community




# Donating with the PayPal Giving Fund
